Participants will be determined in the order of their time and date of registration. Contract "party" bridge rules as played by the Westminster Village's Monday group will apply. Winners determined by top scores.

### BRIDGE (DUPLICATE): (Saguaro Lounge) Friday, March 8 at 12:30pm

Register only as partners. Only one partner needs to sign up for both people, indicating who they will be playing with on the back sheet. We can accommodate five tables of four people. Participants will be determined in the order of their time and date of registration. Standard Duplicate Bridge procedures and scoring will be used to determine the three best couples. Winners will be awarded with the special Myra Blaker Bridge Game Memorial Medal for 2024.

### HAND & FOOT: (Crossroads) Friday, March 8 at 10:00am

Standard Hand & Foot rules apply. Copies of the house rules will be given out. We can accommodate only four tables of four people. Enjoy an afternoon of excitement!
